

1 On July 6, 2007, the Board became aware of the above information and calls were placed
2 to Licensee on that date to notify her that she should cease from seeing any patients and
3 representing herself as an optometrist until she was licensed by the Board.

4 Licensee has since obtained a valid license with the Oregon Board of Optometry, which
5 was issued on July 9, 2007.

6 On September 19, 2007, a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action was served on
7 Licensee via certified mail, return receipt requested. The Notice was received and signed for by
8 M. H. Eagles on September 20, 2007. In that notice, it provided that if Licensee failed to request
9 a hearing within the specified 21 days, that a default order would be entered and the Board's file
10 would be the record.

11 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

12 The Board alleges that the acts and conduct of Licensee described above constitute
13 violations of ORS 683.020 (license required to practice optometry); 683.140(1)(c)
14 (unprofessional conduct, or for gross ignorance or inefficiency in the profession) and ORS
15 683.180(7) (practicing optometry in this state without having at the time a valid unrevoked
16 license from the board.)

17 ORDER

18 The Board issues a Reprimand to Licensee's license. In addition, the Board assesses
19 licensee a \$250 civil penalty payable within 30 days.
